COMMUNITY BUILDING CIRCLES & RESTORATIVE PROBLEM SOLVING CIRCLES

Restorative Practices create safe supportive school culture based on inclusion, equity, empathy, compassion, and accountability. Community Building Circles are a trauma-informed process that focus on enhancing students' connection to each other and the school community. Restorative Problem-Solving Circles are a peer driven trauma-informed process that encourages students to be accountable for repairing harm they caused, and the relationships impacted. These processes decrease truancy and suspensions while increasing graduation rates.
