


## **2,080 signups** to bring NOEA Day at no cost to schools and community-based orgs:


- 227 were Centene schools/CBOs
- 61% of schools are Title I



## NOEA 2024: Let's Grow - Planting New Connections



Quality social connection results in several physical, mental, and social benefits such as 50% increase in longevity, lower rates of anxiety and depression, higher self-esteem, and better school performance. Social connections also create more resilient communities, in the face of disaster situations.

**Goal:** 2,500 schools, with 10% being brand new to NOEA

Overall Centene Goal: 500 schools

SOCIAL CONNECTION FACT CARD



People with strong perceptions of community belongingness are 2.6 times more likely to report good or excellent health than people with a low sense of belongingness.<sup>1</sup>

Children and adolescents who enjoy positive relationships with their peers, parents, and teachers experience improved academic outcomes.<sup>1</sup>








A thoughtfully assembled activity box to run a NOEA Day. Inside, you'll find:







- Use one of our email templates for ease of outreach (COMING SOON ON CENTENE HUB) or try to get in touch with the school secretary.






- If you are planning to go to a school, connect with a staff member and some student leaders to help you organize NOEA Day in advance.
- Have students help set up an activity station for the mural project and calling their peers over to participate.
- Print out copies of the Conversation Cards and lay out on the lunch tables. Participate alongside the students. Modeling meeting new people helps them get out of their shell!



## **Considerations and Talking Points**


- Use more language around ending social isolation vs. anti-bullying
- If you are planning to do an assembly at a school, use our NOEA
   Assembly Guide (COMING IN JANUARY ON CENTENE HUB) for
   guidance on what to discuss. Emphasis can be on defining what social
   isolation is and how to cultivate social connections at school.
- The NOEA program is a comprehensive set of school-based activities and lesson plans encourage youth to sit with others, find new friends, and model ways to end social isolation.
- Over 2,000 schools participate every year.
- NOEA listed as a <u>top recommendation</u> to foster social connection in schools by the Surgeon General's Office.
- NOEA Day can be celebrated anytime other than February 16th, and Conversation Cards can be used anytime for brain breaks during class, group counseling sessions, club


